The Chairman has been notified by the Photo Shop that the non-glare glass for the Coe portraits has been ordered from Larsen Juhl but delivery has been delayed another two weeks.

The Chairman will follow up with Write Way Signs regarding the plaque acknowledging the Coe family.

#### **Old Business**

The Chairman received a quote from John Ciesco re polishing of the All Wars Memorial plaques. The pricing is as follows: Fountain Plaque, \$900.00; 2 Large Plaques, \$2,000.00; 13 Plaques plus the crown on the top of the flag pole, \$30,000.00. The Committee believes it is feasible and doable to perform the work incrementally. We would like to get another estimate on this job and realize this expense may require a RFP.

The Committee needs to develop a signage policy for the Park.

The Committee needs to set a date to review Margaret Keywan's Coe Memorial Park files.

#### New Business

The Chairman made the Committee aware of a City holiday lighting proposal conveyed by Brett Simmons. The idea to include the Park in the City's holiday lighting is appealing. The Committee is open to the use of the Birch Grove as a trial for this season, provided there are white lights available for use. The Committee is also open to further discussion of more extensive Park lighting for next year.
