Ms. Malanca noted revised plans have been received from the applicant's engineer, Hrica Associates, LLC, in response to City Staff, engineering comments. The plans address the run off concerns, with contaminants running into the pond. The runoff is now going away from the pond, and it has own retention basin. The City's engineer, Paul Kundzins, has submitted a memo dated 3/20/18. Ms. Malanca read the memo into the record from Mr. Kundzins, endorsing the changes that have been made to the plans prepared by Hrica Associates LLC.

Mr. Bate inquired about the potential location of a dumpster on site, if this location eventually becomes a brewery. In the past we have had issues with dumpsters tucked away almost into the wetlands area. Mr. Henry noted a trash receptacle area on the map. The map was reviewed and the applicant Mr. Doug Henry noted gravel would be going into that area (pointing at map). There are some existing concrete pads on site.
