#### 4. Old Business:

a. Show Cause Hearing

Property Owner: Ron Raymond

Address: Felicity Lane, Assessor Map 101 Block 011 Lot 008 Violation: Grading and material processing within a regulated area

without permits

Discussion – no site plans available yet

Mr. Leifert provided background information and the history of this property. Corporation Counsel Vic Muschell has provided notice to the property owner. Mr. Leifert has spoken with Ron Raymond, who has now hired Kenneth Hrica, PE, to design a single family house for this property, so a plan is in place for development. Mr. Leifert has spoken with Mr. Hrica who verified he is working on such a plan.

Address: 37 Stoneridge Drive, Assessor Map 121 Block 001 Lot 005

Violation: Work in regulated area without permits

Mr. Leifert screen shared photos of the site, and provided background history on this property. Jose Bonilla appeared and explained what he is doing, and he has hired contractors to address this situation.

b. Applicant: Stephen GirolimonLocation: 194 Linton Street

Activity: Place fill in regulated upland review area for lawn expansion; restore

670 square feet of wetlands from previous filling activity

Dennis McMorrow, PE, Berkshire Engineering and Surveying, Bantam, CT appeared representing the applicant, providing maps and explanation of the proposed activity.

Discussion followed, with Mr. Leifert noting findings from past site visits, with follow up from Mr. McMorrow.

MOTION by Mr. Kalinowski to accept this proposed activity, and that this is not a significant activity requiring a public hearing, seconded by Mr. Storti, unanimously carried.
