Since October 1, 2023, Drakeville firefighters have responded to 17 calls for service and have achieved a 100% response rate to those calls. Firefighters also responded mutual aid to the town of Goshen for a residential structure fire. More information is below:

Also since October 1, Drakeville members have completed a cumulative total of 150 training hours. We have 1 firefighter who passed their Q Endorsement class, which allows them to begin driving our apparatus. We also have 1 firefighter currently enrolled in the Firefighter II program at Litchfield County Regional Fire School. Forward looking, we have 4 firefighters signed up to take the Firefighter I class beginning February at the fire school, which will allow them to serve as interior firefighters.

Total current manpower is 4 interior, 7 exterior and 2 explorers. Four of the seven exteriors will be qualified as interior firefighters once they complete some training pre-requisites online, which is imminent.

Drakeville also took part in Torrington's Light Up Main event on November 24, where all three apparatus were able to participate. On November 25, Drakeville hosted its annual boot drive on Main Street, which was very successful.
