

On 10/17/2023 at approximately 0400 hours, Officer Arvelo was patrolling the business parking lot of the Ocean State Job Lot (681 Main Street).

While conducting an extra patrol at that location, Officer Arvelo observed a 2003 color blue Saab parked, with what appeared to be a German Shepherd seated in the passenger seat of the vehicle, generating case 23-36637 (a suspicious vehicle). Officer Arvelo then reported to observe a male occupant sleeping, located inside of the vehicle. Upon Officer Arvelo performing a query of the vehicle's registration through COLLECT, it was then discovered that the registered owner, identified as Jonathan Boruta (1/12/1978) had two active FELONY PRAWN Arrest Warrants. Officer Arvelo then backed away from the vehicle and notified myself, (Sergeant Gonska) of his findings.


