January 25, 2022 Referendum

The Electors of the Town of Torrington are hereby warned to meet at one polling place in said town on Tuesday, January 25, 2022, for the following purpose:

To vote on the following question for the approval or disapproval, a vote of "Yes" being a vote for approval, and a vote of "No" being a vote for disapproval:

"Shall the City of Torrington appropriate an additional \$20,000,000 (thereby increasing the appropriation and bond authorization approved by the voters on November 3, 2020 from \$159,575,000 to \$179,575,000) for the construction of a new high school, a new middle school, a new central administrative office, and for the demolition of the existing Torrington High School, and authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds and notes in the same amount to finance said appropriation? Yes _____ No _____"

The full text of the proposed question with explanatory text, printed in accordance with Sec. 9-369b of the CT General Statutes, is available at the City Clerk's office for public distribution.

The vote on the proposed question is taken pursuant to Section C13-8 and C13-9 of the Charter of the City of Torrington.

Notice is hereby given that the location of the polling place for all voting districts is at the City Hall Auditorium/Council Chambers, Room 218, City Hall, 140 Main Street, Torrington, CT.

Absentee Ballots will be counted at the following central location on the date of the Referendum: Room 224, City Hall, 140 Main St., Torrington.

All non-resident property owners are eligible to vote on the question in one location only: Room 133, City Hall, 140 Main St., Torrington.

Voting machines will be used. The polls will be opened at six o'clock in the morning (6:00 a.m.) and will remain open until eight o'clock in the evening (8:00 p.m.).
