WARNING OF ELECTORS MEETING

The Electors of the Town and City of Torrington are hereby warned to meet at their respective polling places in said Town and City on Tuesday, November 2, 2021, for the following purposes to wit:

1. To elect, by use of voting machines, a Mayor, six (6) Members of the Board of Councilmen, a Town & City Clerk, a Treasurer, three (3) Selectmen, five (5) Members of the Board of Education, seven (7) Constables, and three (3) Members of the Board of Public Safety, being all of the Town and City offices required and authorized by law to be elected at said meeting.
2. To vote on the following question for the approval or disapproval of the proposed repurposing of a previously approved appropriation and bond authorization, a vote of "YES" being a vote for approval, and a vote of "NO" being a vote for disapproval:

"Shall the City of Torrington repurpose the \$700,000 appropriation and bond authorization previously approved by the voters on November 6, 2018 from the window replacement project at the Middle School to roof improvements at Torrington Public Schools?"

The full text of the proposed question, with explanatory text, printed in accordance with §2-30a of the General Statutes, is available at the City Clerk's office for public distribution.

Central counting of Absentee Ballots will be conducted in Room 215 in City Hall at 140 Main St., Torrington beginning at 4:00 p.m.

All property owners who are not registered voters in Torrington may vote on the question in one location only: Room 133 City Hall, 140 Main St., Torrington.
