

November 3, 2020 State Election

The Electors of the Town of Torrington are hereby warned to meet at their respective polling places in said town on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, for the following purposes:

- I. To cast their votes for Presidential and Vice-Presidential electors, Representative in Congress, State Senator, State Representative, and Registrar of Voters.
- II. To vote on the following question for the approval or disapproval, a vote of "Yes" being a vote for approval, and a vote of "No" being a vote for disapproval:

"Shall the City of Torrington appropriate \$159,575,000 for the construction of a new high school, a new middle school, a new central administrative office, and for the demolition of the existing Torrington High School, and authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds and notes in the same amount to finance said appropriation?
Yes___ No___"

The full text of the proposed question with explanatory text, printed in accordance with Sec. 9-369b of the CT General Statutes, is available at the City Clerk's office for public distribution.

The vote on the proposed question is taken pursuant to Section C13-8 and C13-9 of the Charter of the City of Torrington.

All non-resident property owners are eligible to vote on the question in one location only: *Room 133, City Hall, 140 Main St., Torrington.*

Voting machines will be used. The polls will be opened at six o'clock in the morning (6:00 a.m.) and will remain open until eight o'clock in the evening (8:00 p.m.).
