Highland Avenue Reconstruction


On a motion by Councilor Rubino, seconded by Councilor Soliani, the Council voted unanimously to accept the recommendation of the City Engineer and Deputy Public Works Director to re-award the contract for the Highland Avenue Reconstruction project to A & J Construction of Brookfield, CT, as described in Paul Kundzins memo dated April 30, 2019, for \$1,140,212.81 with up to \$86,420.93 for contingencies and incidentals, and authorize the Mayor to act on behalf of the City regarding the award and execution of the contract agreement.
