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A **REGULAR MEETING** of the Ordinance Subcommittee of the City Council and Water Pollution Control Authority was held at City Hall in Room 215 on Monday, October 5, 2020. **Franklin Plaza**

Chairman Rubino read aloud a memorandum from Corporation Counsel Victor Muschell recommending that §75-3 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Torrington be amended to allow alcoholic beverages on a limited basis at Franklin Plaza. The committee discussed the recommendation.

On a motion by Councilman Cavagnero, seconded by Chairman Rubino, the committee voted unanimously to recommend to the City Council that a public hearing be scheduled to solicit citizen feedback regarding the proposed ordinance revision.

**Business by Committee Members**


