A “**VIRTUAL**” **PUBLIC HEARING** of the City Council & WPC Authority was held on Monday, October 19, 2020 to solicit citizen input regarding a possible amendment to §75-3 of the Code of Ordinances to allow alcoholic beverages on a limited basis at Franklin Plaza. Pursuant to the Governor’s Executive Order No. 7B, there was no physical location. Members of the public were encouraged to submit their comments in writing to the City Clerk’s Office prior to the start of the public hearing. City Council members and the public were able to attend the meeting remotely using the ZOOM online meeting platform.

The meeting was attended in-person by Mayor Elinor Carbone, Corporation Counsel Victor Muschell, Acting WPCA Administrator Ed Tousey, IT Director Gerry Crowley and City Councilors Frank Rubino, Anne Ruwet, David Oliver and Sharon Waagner. Public Works Director Ray Drew, Economic Development Director Rista Malanca, City Comptroller Alice Proulx, Fleet Manager Emil Castro, Parks and Recreation Superintendent Brett Simmons and City Councilors Paul Cavagnero and Drake Waldron joined by ZOOM.

Mayor Carbone called the Public Hearing to order at 6:37 p.m.

Assistant City Clerk Jonathan Draper read the legal notice that was published on the City’s website on October 7, 2020.
