

A **PUBLIC HEARING** was held by the Torrington Board of Councilmen, herein acting as the Water Pollution Control Authority, in the City Hall Auditorium on Monday, June 3, 2019, to solicit citizen input regarding the Sewer User Fee for the year beginning July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020.
