

A **REGULAR MEETING** was held by the Ordinance subcommittee of the City Council & WPC Authority on Monday, April 1, 2019 at the City Hall Auditorium.

Present were Mayor Elinor Carbone, Chairman Gregg Cogswell, and Councilwoman Anne Ruwet. Corporation Counsel Atty. Victor Muschell was also present. Councilman Paul Cavagnero was absent.

Chairman Cogswell called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m.

Tobacco/Vaping Ordinance

Atty. Muschell presented a draft ordinance that would raise the legal age for the sale of tobacco and vaping products to 21. The Board discussed similar legislation that was proposed at the state legislature.

On a motion by Councilwoman Ruwet, seconded by Councilman Cogswell, the committee voted unanimously to forward the draft ordinance to the full Council to schedule a public hearing to solicit citizen input regarding the proposed ordinance.

Residential/Overnight Parking Ordinance

Mayor Carbone and Atty. Muschell presented a revised draft of Chapter 194 of the Code of Ordinances. The committee discussed the proposed changes which included new policies regarding commerce parking permits, overnight visitor parking permits, and a downtown residential parking permit program. The committee agreed to meet again in two weeks to discuss the ordinance revisions further.

Adjournment

On a motion by Councilwoman Ruwet, seconded by Councilman Cogswell, the committee voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 6:27 p.m.
