

A **REGULAR MEETING** was held by the Ordinance subcommittee of the City Council & WPC Authority on Monday, April 15, 2019 at the City Hall Auditorium.

Present were Mayor Elinor Carbone, Chairman Gregg Cogswell, Corporation Counsel Atty. Victor Muschell, Police Chief William Baldwin, Jr., and Traffic Operations Unit Supervisor Steven Pisarski. Councilwoman Anne Ruwet joined by telephone. Councilman Paul Cavagnero arrived at 6:23 p.m.

Chairman Cogswell called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m.

**Residential/Overnight Parking Ordinance**

Mayor Carbone provided an executive summary of the proposed changes to the Code of Ordinances Chapter 194 – Vehicles and Traffic. The committee discussed the proposed changes, including the establishment of a downtown residential parking permit program. Chief Baldwin recommended changing the fines for parking violations and Officer Pisarski recommended extending the hours of operation for parking meters to 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. every day, with the exception of Sundays and holidays.

**Motion to Schedule a Public Hearing**


On a motion by Councilman Cavagnero, seconded by Councilwoman Ruwet, the committee voted unanimously to recommend to the full City Council that a public hearing be held on May 6, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. to solicit citizen input regarding the proposed changes.

On a motion by Councilwoman Ruwet, seconded by Councilman Cavagnero, the committee voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 6:28 p.m.
