A **REGULAR MEETING** of the Ordinance Subcommittee of the City Council and Water Pollution Control Authority was held at City Hall in Room 215 on Monday, November 9, 2020. The meeting was attended in-person by Chairman Frank Rubino and Councilwoman Anne Ruwet. Councilman Paul Cavagnero was absent.

Chairman Rubino called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m.

**Discussion Regarding Noise Ordinance**

The committee reviewed the noise ordinance for the City of Derby and discussed the possibility of establishing a similar ordinance for Torrington. Chairman Rubino suggested that a public hearing be scheduled to solicit citizen input and Councilor Ruwet cautioned that the City should prepare its draft of the ordinance before scheduling a public hearing. Chairman Rubino and Councilor Ruwet expressed interest in pursuing an enforcement policy that does not involve decibel levels and Chairman Rubino suggested tabling any action until more information is gathered.

**Business by Committee Members**

Chairman Rubino opened the meeting up to business by the committee members but no further business was presented or discussed.

**Adjournment**

On a motion by Councilwoman Ruwet, seconded by Chairman Rubino, the committee voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 6:12 p.m.
