All work shall conform to the standards and provisions of same.

Bids submitted shall be deemed to include the Contract Document information as shown in Addendum No. 1. General bidders shall notify sub-bidders that may be affected by this addendum as applicable. Bidders shall be required to acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the space provided on the Bid Proposal Form, Page BP-1. Failure to acknowledge this Addendum by the Bidder may result in the rejection of their bid. Bidders are directed to review changes to all portions of the work as changes to one portion may affect the work of another.

With reference to Item 0403800A Cold In Place Recycling and Item 0403802A Mix Design, the thickness of the cold-in-place recycled processed material as placed by the paver shall be between 3.5 inches and 5.0 inches compacted finished thickness as determined by the mix design recommendations as based on the depth of existing HMA pavement.**

The project work includes cold-in-place recycling of approximately 3.6 miles of various roads and associated miscellaneous work. Roads include; Sawmill Hill Rd (Eichner Rd to Winchester Town Line), Babbling Brook Rd, Starks Rd, Menahga La., Rossi Rd, Town Farm Rd, Pumping Station Rd.

A bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid shall accompany each bid. A non-collusion statement for Prime Contractors and any addendum acknowledgement must also be submitted at the time of the bid.
