Property Owner: Ron Raymond

Address: Felicity Lane, Assessor Map 101 Block 011 Lot 008 Violation: Grading and material processing within a regulated area

without permits

Discussion – no site plans available yet

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Mr. Leifert updated the Commission on the status of this violation. He has met with property owner Ron Raymond in the City Hall office to review progress. Kenneth Hrica, PE is preparing plans for the Commission's review. Mr. Raymond has received permission to move stockpiles of material and equipment near front of property. A plan needs to be provided by the property owner to this Commission to show the wetlands boundaries.

6. New Business:

a. Applicant: Michael Gutowski Location: 259 Westside Road

Activity: Septic system repair within regulated area, with proposed wetlands

crossing

Dennis McMorrow, PE of Berkshire Engineering and Surveying, Bantam, CT appeared representing the applicant. Mr. Leifert shared his screen with Commission members, presenting the plans prepared by Mr. McMorrow. Mr. McMorrow reviewed the plans. Much of this site has heavy clay material that is not suitable for a septic system. There is an old wood road on this property that has been selected as the wetlands crossing. A stabilization fabric will be placed across the road and covered with gravel to allow access by construction vehicles. This area has already been disturbed and is clear, and is the best spot on this property to cross the wetlands area.

Mr. Leifert stated a review is forthcoming from the City's Engineer.

MOTION by Ms. Bakker to accept the application from Michael Gutowski, Location: 259 Westside Road, activity: septic system repair within regulated area, with proposed wetlands crossing, and that this proposal is not a significant activity requiring a public hearing. Motion seconded by Ms. Altman, motion unanimously carried.
