Mr. Leifert updated the Commission on the email he had sent to the property owner last week. It was the consensus of everyone present that enough time has been extended to allow the property owner to submit the required mapping information. b. Enforcement Update.

Mr. Leifert noted this Enforcement Report has not changed since the last Commission meeting. However, the Whittlesey property on Newfield Road has grown steadily worse over time. Lumber is being brought in, and this is a sawmill, not an agricultural use as originally planned. The traffic involved with the lumber is creating a mess, especially with the snow melt and condition of the property.
