Kenneth Hrica, PE, Hrica Engineering and Surveying appeared before the Commission. The background history of this project was briefly reviewed.

George Logan, Wetlands Scientist appeared via zoom and outlined his credentials. A wetlands mitigation plan was presented, and notes have been placed on the plans for the contractor. Ken Hrica distributed mitigation plans to Commission members.

Mr. Logan gave a presentation, he was on the site on July 11, 2022, and this is an isolated wetlands area. He has walked the entire property with the property owner. Mr. Logan provided details of his site walk and findings. Seeding and plantings were discussed, as well as the large number of shrubs planned. A detailed presentation was given by Mr. Logan.

Mr. Nardi-Cyrus reviewed his memo to the Commission.

Ms. Altman inquired about oversight of this project. Mr. Logan responded there will be a three year oversight of this restoration plan, by himself or another qualified person.
