

MITIGATION IMPLEMENTATION NOTES:

- 1. The New England Roadside Matrix Upland Seed Mix shall be used for upland restoration.
- 2. The New England Roadside Matrix Wet Meadow Seed Mix shall be used for wetland restoration
- 3. Prior to seeding the planting medium in Areas #1 and #2, shall be prepared by tilling the lawn areas to a depth of 6 to 8 inches (e.g., roto-tilling)
- 4. The planting bed shall be fertilized (e.g., Milorgonite) and pH adjusted to 6.8 7.2 by liming.
- 5. Seed shall be applied with a nurse crop, at 10% by weight, such annual ryegrass.
- 6. The seeded areas shall be watered and covered with a thin layer of weed free straw.
- 7. In the late fall seeding can take place after the first hard frost or in mid- to late April.
- 8. In rear wooded portion of the property approximately 10-inches, on average, of deposited sandy material shall be removed (i.e., Wetland Restoration Area #3) and seeded with the wetland seed mix
- 9. Inspection/Monitoring shall take place for two years after implementation with memo to Town staff.
- 10. Removal of invasive plants shall take place during the 2-year monitoring period.
