

**MINUTES
PUBLIC HEARING
CITY COUNCIL
ONLINE (ZOOM)
March 1, 2021**

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A **“VIRTUAL” PUBLIC HEARING** of the Board of Councilmen was held on Monday, March 1, 2021 to solicit citizen input regarding a Tax Exemption Agreement, per C.G.S. § 7-498, for certain real property and improvements located at 100 Franklin Street. Pursuant to the Governor’s Executive Order No. 7B, there was no physical location for the public hearing. Members of the public were encouraged to submit their comments in writing to the City Clerk’s Office prior to the start of the public hearing. City Council members and the public were able to attend the meeting remotely using the ZOOM online meeting platform.
