

Electronic Waste (E-Waste) Recycling

On January 1, 2011, computers, monitors, printers and televisions were banned from the trash and are not be picked up curbside so Torrington residents are encouraged to take advantage of our e-waste recycle service.

City of Torrington residents can bring their household electronic scrap items (e-waste) to the Water Pollution Control Facility Drop-Site Recycle Center located on Bogue Road for recycling.

The e-waste recycle drop-off site will be open Monday thru Friday from 7:00 am to 2:30 pm and weekends from 7:00 to 9:30 am. Proof of residency and sign-in is required.

Data Security is not included with the e-waste recycle program so residents need to take appropriate steps to properly sanitize or destroy all storage media.

The e-waste that can be recycled from Torrington households includes:

Computers	IPods and PDAs
Computer monitors	Stereo
Printers	Radio equipment
Modems	Telephones and telephone equipment
Computer	Typewriters
Peripherals (keyboards, mouse's etc.)	Speakers
Televisions	Microwave ovens
Cell phones	Digital cameras
Desktop copiers	VCRs and DVD players
Fax machines	

You can also bring your household fluorescent bulbs and batteries to the Drop-Site Recycle Center for recycling.
