## Small Cities – Friendly Hands Food Bank

Councilor Waldron questioned whether Friendly Hands owns the property, and if the money will come back to the City once the property is sold. Councilors discussed it and determined that this property is owned by Friendly Hands Food Bank and that once the property is sold, they will use the proceeds to purchase a new property.
