Letter to Torrington Refuse & Recycle Haulers

Re: Application for Refuse Collection License

Dear Hauler:

I am enclosing the application for your refuse collection license. Please complete and return with your check, made payable to the City of Torrington, by June 30, 2016. New expiration stickers will then be issued and should be displayed on the Torrington License decal. The application and forms can also be downloaded from the City Website on the [Torrington Solid Waste Department](#) page (look for MSW Hauler License Application link).

You are also herein notified that the City of Torrington requires all non-residential generators to recycle the following designated materials: glass and metal food containers, non-residential office paper, newspapers, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, white & colored paper, old corrugated cardboard, boxboard, waste oil, scrap metal, lead acid storage batteries, covered electronic devices, leaves and grass. Refuse haulers are required to notify the City about any customer believed to be discarding designated recyclables with solid waste.

Also, as you are already aware, the State of Connecticut pursuant to Public Act 10-87 requires haulers to register with the municipality, to disclose specific information and submit an annual solid waste and recycling report to the City. The State Solid Waste and Recycling Reporting Forms can be found on the DEEP website on the [DEEP Municipal Recycling Resource Center](#) page (look for "Solid Waste and Recycling Reporting Forms"). Copies of the DEEP instructions and reporting forms are also posted on the City Website at the link noted in the first paragraph.

The list of licensed haulers will be forwarded to CRRA. Only licensed refuse collectors will be allowed to bring Torrington wastes to the Torrington Transfer station.
